#### HIS DISCIPLES KNEW WHO HE WAS

**John 20:27** Then saith he to Thomas, **Reach hither thy finger, and behold my hands; and reach hither thy hand, and thrust it into my side: and be not faithless, but believing.** **John 20:28** And Thomas answered and said unto him, My Lord and my God.

**Acts 1:2** Until the day in which he was taken up, after that he through the **Holy Ghost** had given commandments unto the apostles whom he had chosen: **Acts 1:5** **For John truly baptized with water; but ye shall be baptized with the Holy Ghost not many days hence.**

#### WHAT DID HIS DISCIPLES TEACH

**Acts 2:38** Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.

#### IS THE HOLY GHOST NECESSARY IF YOU HAVE BEEN BAPTIZED IN JESUS NAME?

**Acts 8:14** Now when the apostles which were at Jerusalem heard that Samaria had received the word of God, they sent unto them Peter and John: **15** Who, when they were come down, prayed for them, that they might receive the Holy Ghost: **16** **(For as yet he was fallen upon none of them: only they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus.)** **17** Then laid they their hands on them, and they received the Holy Ghost.

#### IS BAPTISM NECESSARY IF YOU HAVE ALREADY RECEIVED THE HOLY GHOST

**Acts 10:44** While Peter yet spake these words, the Holy Ghost fell on all them which heard the word. **45** And they of the circumcision which believed were astonished, as many as came with Peter, because that on the Gentiles also was poured out the gift of the Holy Ghost.



**Acts 10:46** For they heard them speak with tongues, and magnify God. Then answered Peter, **47** Can any man forbid water, that these should not be baptized, which have received the Holy Ghost as well as we? **48** And he commanded them to be baptized in the name of the Lord. Then prayed they him to tarry certain days.

#### IS THE HOLY GHOST NECESSARY IF YOU "BELIEVE"

**Acts 19:1** And it came to pass, that, while Apollos was at Corinth, Paul having passed through the upper coasts came to Ephesus: and finding certain disciples, **2** **He said unto them, Have ye received the Holy Ghost since ye believed? And they said unto him, We have not so much as heard whether there be any Holy Ghost.** **3.** And he said unto them, Unto what then were ye baptized? And they said, Unto John's baptism. **4** Then said Paul, John verily baptized with the baptism of repentance, saying unto the people, that they should believe on him which should come after him, that is, on Christ Jesus. **5** When they heard this, they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. **6** And when Paul had laid his hands upon them, the Holy Ghost came on them; and they spake with tongues, and prophesied.

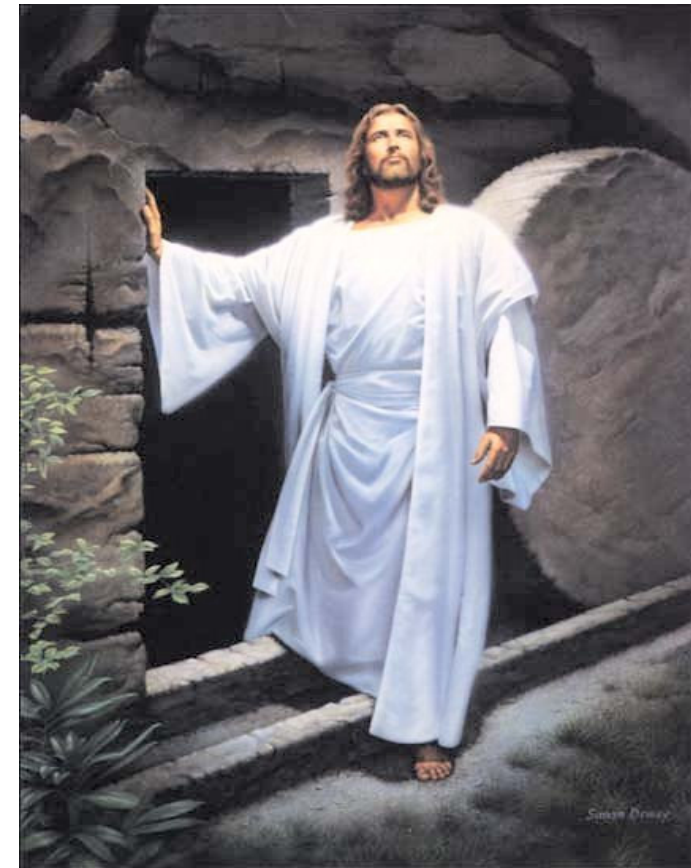

## Let us Introduce you to Jesus

**John 14:9** Jesus saith unto him, **Have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known me, Philip? he that hath seen me hath seen the Father; and how sayest thou then Shew us the Father?**



**1 Timothy 3:16** And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifest in the flesh, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory.

The plan of Salvation is found in it's entirety only in the book of Acts of The Apostles.

The first four books of the New Testament, also called the Gospels, tell of the birth of Jesus, His deity, the calling of His disciples, his miracles, His death, burial and resurrection.

The books Romans through Jude were written to edify, or encourage the Churches that were established in the Book of Acts.

Revelations is also called The Revelation of Jesus Christ. To fully understand the plan of Salvation, we must first look at who Jesus is.

There is only One God. God is a Spirit, a Holy Spirit. Jesus was the Son of God after the flesh, but was the very, One and only, God of all Creation after the Spirit. This is the reason Jesus had the authority to forgive sins: **Mark 2:5** When Jesus saw their faith, he said unto the sick of the palsy, **Son, thy sins be forgiven thee.**

**Matthew 4:10** Then saith Jesus unto him, **Get thee hence, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve.**

Jesus allowed himself to be worshipped many times. His Disciples worshipped him. God commanded the angels to worship Jesus when he was born. Jesus allowed himself to be worshipped before or after almost every miracle that was recorded. He was not another God. He was God manifested in the flesh.

**John 10:30 I and my Father are one.**

**John 14:2-4** In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, [there] ye may be also. And whither I go ye know, and the way ye know.

**John 14:5** Thomas saith unto him, Lord, we know not whither thou goest; and how can we know the way?

**John 14:6-7** Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me. If ye had known me, ye should have known my Father also: **and from henceforth ye know him, and have seen him.**

**John 14:8** Philip saith unto him, Lord, shew us the Father, and it sufficeth us.

**John 14:9-11** Jesus saith unto him, **Have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known me, Philip? he that hath seen me hath seen the Father; and how sayest thou then, Shew us the Father? Believest thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in me? the words that I speak unto you I speak not of myself: but the Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the works. Believe me that I am in the Father, and the Father in me: or else believe me for the very works' sake.**

**John 16:25-28** **These things have I spoken unto you in proverbs: but the time cometh, when I shall no more speak unto you in proverbs, but I shall shew you plainly of the Father.**

At that day ye shall ask in my name: and I say not unto you, that I will pray the Father for you: For the Father himself loveth you, because ye have loved me, and have believed that I came out from God. I came forth from the Father, and am come into the world: again, I leave the world, and go to the Father.

JESUS WAS DEAD! PROMISE NOT FULFILLED

A short few days later, Jesus was dead! The promise to his disciples, "but the time cometh, when I shall no more speak unto you in proverbs, but I shall shew you plainly of the Father," unfulfilled!

John 19:38 And after this Joseph of Arimathaea, being a disciple of Jesus, but secretly for fear of the Jews, besought Pilate that he might take away the body of Jesus: and Pilate gave [him] leave. He came therefore, and took the body of Jesus.

## DEATH COULD NOT HOLD HIM

**Acts 1:3** To whom also he shewed himself alive after his passion by many infallible proofs, being seen of them forty days, and speaking of the things pertaining to the kingdom of God:

PROMISE FULFILLED FROM BEYOND THE GRAVE

John 20:19-22 Then the same day at evening, being the first day of the week, when the doors were shut where the disciples were assembled for fear of the Jews, came Jesus and stood in the midst, and saith unto them, **Peace be unto you.** And when he had so said, he shewed unto them his hands and his side. Then were the disciples glad, when they saw the Lord. Then said Jesus to them again, **Peace be unto you: as my Father hath sent me, even so send I you.** And when he had said this, he breathed on them, and saith unto them, **Receive ye the Holy Ghost:**

HOLY GHOST IS SECOND BREATH OF THE ALMIGHTY GOD

When God created the first man Adam, he breathed into his nostrils the "breath of life and man became a living soul. Because of the breath of God making man a living soul, the soul of man will live forever somewhere. Either in Heaven with Jesus or with the demons in hell.

Because of sin man was sentenced to death, we as humans inherited that sentence. God made a way of escape from the law of sin and death. He wrapped himself in a form of man, Christ Jesus, and went to the cross for our Salvation.

The blood of animal sacrifices could not take away sin; however, Jesus died for the sins of the whole world. That means past sins, (the sins that were rolled ahead year by year by the blood of the animal sacrifices), were rolled ahead to Calvary. This mountain of sins dissipated when they rolled up to the Cross of Calvary.
